PACK PRINT INTERNATIONAL 2025 closes on a high: Milestone 10th edition draws 14,327 visitors from 65 countries and regions

Singapore, 6 October 2025 - After four dynamic days at BITEC, Bangkok, PACK PRINT INTERNATIONAL (PPI) 2025 closed on a high — a landmark edition for ASEAN's packaging and printing industries, held alongside the synergistic CorruTec ASIA.

The 10th edition of PACK PRINT INTERNATIONAL welcomed 14,327 visitors from 65 countries and regions — a more than 15 percent increase over the 2023 edition.
